

DID YOU KNOW you can still write and object before 30th June!

Barton RA and Middleton Tyas RA have appointed a variety of specialist consultants to supply technical data regarding this planning application which has been kindly funded by some very generous donations. Now we need your help by putting your thoughts in a letter and sending it to the addresses overleaf. The bullet points below may help you to gather your thoughts.

- Additional traffic will pass through Barton and Middleton Tyas past our houses and schools
- Dust from the existing quarry dirties cars and windows but the new quarry will do more. Dust may also affect existing health conditions such as asthma
- The noise and vibration from current works can be felt in local properties
- The quarry will not provide any new jobs and the jobs suggested for the remaining development may be detrimental to the existing jobs in our area
- Ancient parkland will be exchanged for a permanent scar to the landscape
- Wildlife will be disturbed by a new quarry
- The quarry garden will permanently adversely alter the historic landscape
- There is no justification for the quarry to support the Hall as the cost of the renovations could be financed by normal means
- The value of the limestone to be extracted is estimated to be far in excess of that required to fund the renovation works
- There is no need to release any more crushed rock into the North East as current reserves are more than sufficient
- The application site has not been identified within the development plan as being in a preferred area or within an area of search for new quarries
